Eva Jeler is the National Coach - Performance Pathway (Able-Bodied) for Table Tennis Australia. Eva is one of the world's leading coaches, having spent 37 years working with the German Table Tennis Federation (DTTB). In that time, Eva held roles as the German Head Coach, National Coach for the Youth Program, plus Head Coach for Youth Teams and Cadet Teams.

In 1983 after a less-than-perfect performance by the German men's team at the World Championships in Tokyo, Eva joined the DTTB as a national coach with the vision to reshuffle the structure of the sport. Eva was charged with the creation and management of the German talent identification system and subsequent youth programme, a system that is still in use today.

It is no coincidence that Germany's international performances went from strength to strength during Eva's tenure, contributing to dozens of medals achieved at the Olympic Games, World Championships and European Championships. Outside of her work in Germany, Eva has also been influential within ITTF Hopes Program at the continental and world level.

Eva has been responsible for producing some of the world's top players.
